

## Framework for Accountable Decision Making

There are *three* things to look for in any **DECISION** that affects you...

## 1. THE REASONS

"REASONS" help explain or provide basis for the decision.

## 2. THE PROCESS

"PROCESS" helps explain how the decision is made, the steps and action taken, people involved in making the decision.

## 3. YOUR ROLE

"ROLE"	helps e	xplain t	he part	you p	olay in	the de	cision.

In a democracy, we should expect and require that all decisions are guided by the following criteria:

- √ Legitimate Reasons: The decisions are based on policies, standards, rules that are fairly applied
- √ *Transparency*: The process used to make the decision is visible to all.
- √ **Opportunities for participation:** There is a role n the decision making process for the individual affected by the decision.

These principles can be used as criteria for accountable decision making in a democracy.
