RQI's strategy is grounded in decades of work with **direct service providers in low-income communities** around the country and was developed in partnership with adult foundational educators.

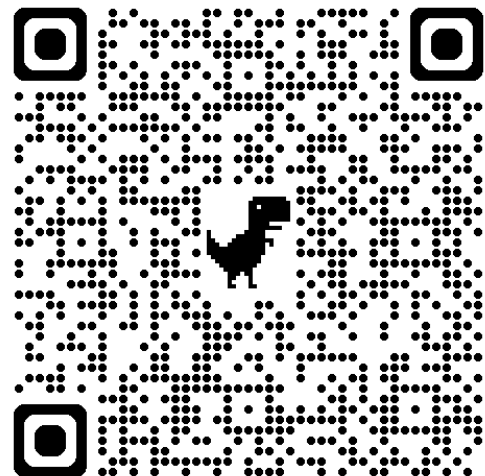
**Question formulation** is an overlooked yet foundational skill for thinking and taking action on your own behalf. When adult educators deliberately teach this skill, their students:

- Strengthen their ability to **think and learn independently**, in the classroom and beyond
- Feel new **agency and confidence** as they navigate systems and participate in decisions that affect them in a range of institutions
- Develop their skills to **advocate** for themselves and their families and take action on their own behalf

RQI, in collaboration with the Open Door Collective of Literacy MN and the Urban Alliance for Adult Literacy, is convening a network of adult educators to collaborate on a community of practice using the Right Question Strategy.
